
60 Days Monsoon Report 2078

(June 11 - August 16, 2021)

In Nepal, 60 districts are affected due to Monsoon-induced disasters (floods, landslides and heavy rainfall) during the initial 60 days of monsoon and 5 thousand 1 hundred and 18 people are relocated to safer places. Damage, rescue and relief operations during this period are mentioned below:

Map of the damages due to Monsoon induced disaster during the initial 60 days of monsoon 2021 (June 11-August 16)












Search, rescue and relief operations in regards to monsoon induced disaster


- 278 people were rescued by helicopter so far. •

10 years human casualties due to monsoon induced Floods, Landslides and Heavy Rainfall






